Society Communication

Once your membership application form has been received by the Membership Officer, you can request to be added to the Regia Anglorum e-group and the Regia Anglorum private Facebook group.

- For the former, send a request to the egroup coordinator (at time of last update, Ian Uzzell) by emailing elists@regia.org.
- For the latter, talk to your group leader. The Facebook group is not visible to non-members and is by invite only. Your group leader will be able to arrange this for you. The name of the group is **Regia Members Info**. Other Facebook groups exist.

It is recommended that you join both of these groups, as they are the primary media of communication for the society. If you are unable to join either of these, you should make your group leader aware, who will ensure that all society communiqués are forwarded to you in a suitable way.

Kit and Equipment

You should be wary of buying vast amounts of equipment straight away. Talk to your group leader about the best way to proceed. If you are considering buying something, ensure that it meets all the relevant regulations, especially the authenticity guide – which applies to everything. If a piece of equipment is intended for battlefield use, ensure it meets the separate requirements of the Master at Arms. Other regulations will apply in different situations. All current regulations are on the website (regia.org/members/documents), if there is any doubt, you should check with the relevant officer.
